This is beta version! It has not been tested.

- o Skin addons do not have to share the skin's name anymore. The addon can define the skin in a file called "skin".

  - o Disabled menus on Mac when the Options dialog is active.
  - o Network shared calendars can choose to use either basic or digest authentication.

  - o Added support for global events in Lua scripts.

The reason probably is the UPX compressor which I'll have to stop using since these false positives give bad reputation to the application (and I don't have high hopes that the antivirus companies would actually fix their products).

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brajan: Conky uses the wallpaper as its background to make the window "transparent". It works quite well if the window is always on the desktop but it doesn't work if the windows overlap each other (like Rainlendar's tooltips). There seems to be some Linux specific issues with the Rainlendar's window updating code which I haven't been able to fix. The code is basically the same in all platforms and the Windows and Mac versions work fine so I'm not exactly sure why it causes problems in Linux.

Ben\_Stone: Mounting problems usually mean that you downloaded only a part of the package so try to download it again. If you still get the error please post the exact error message.

I install Rainlendar Lite 2.3 (b55) Works fine.

I install Beta b.58 (by overwriting, new Rainlendar.exe presents). Works fine.

I install Beta b.59 (by overwriting, new Rainlendar.exe not present). Oops!

Invalid plugins found!

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The reason of my problem is NOD32 antivirus system.

I turn it off, but kernel stay active permanently.

NOD32 deletes rainlendar.exe file during unzip of build 59 folder (without any warnings in turn off mode).

So latest Rainlendar beta installation for NOD32 users is possible only in Windows safe mode or after removing of NOD32 :(

You can do this :

- 1) Ignore the warning message and continue to use the Lite.
- 2) Delete them from "C:\Program Files\Rainlendar2\plugins\" and continue to use the Lite.
- 3) Download and use the Pro version.

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
