This is beta version! It has not been tested.

o Changed the alarm to play the sound with Windows multimedia API so other formats (mp3, mwa, ...) than just wav is supported now too.

o Added header to the alarm element which contains the date of the event and the due time.

o Centered text wasn't drawn in the correct place. Fixed.

o Copying tasks is now possible only to calendars which support them.

o If a skin doesn't contain any default windows all of them are shown.

o Removed the Outlook edit link texts from the print output and from the menus.

o Skins with '#' and '%' in the name or path should work now.

o Added some more error handling to the scripts.

o Fixes to the alarm in weekly recurring tasks.
