I experienced a strange behavior when using Rainlendar set "on desktop" position, then extending the desktop to a second screen.

first, the various items did not "stick" where I put them, and finally all rainlendar windows disappeared. I checked in the .ini file and I found weird X and Y positions (i.e -7333 and -946)

It seems that it happens only with the "on desktop" mode enabled in rainlendar.

Mostly On Desktop works on build 26, but there is a smallish new bug. When it changes date it isn't redrawn where I placed it. Instead it is placed within an x-coordinate according to the resolution of monitor #1 (which in my case is a 800x600 TV). As monitor #2 -- where Rainlendar is at the far right of the screen -- is 1200x1024, it's a bit annoying.

An addition to this bug..

I also face the same problem and have tried to download the latest Beta build as well as the default download. This seems to help somewhat. After install the 3 tabs appear in the top left corner stacked (I can barely see their corners and drag them). OK - once I move them to their correct positions and go to Options -> Lock then they are again thrown to the upperleft corner. No idea why. I tried putting on desktop, on top but same result. Locking them throws them to the corner.
