Hi. Here in Brazil the day light saving time doesn't have a fixed date to start or end. So, I manually configure my PC when to start and end the time changes (I do this every year to keep my clock precise). What happens is that Rainlendar shows November 4 two times (the day light saving time started at November 5, midnight), Saturday and Sunday of the same month. This means that all following days falls at wrong week days. This is happing only in November window. December window shows month days and week days at right place. Could this behavior be some kind of bug? There is a way to fix that? I'm afraid that, when day light saving time ends, at February 25, this will happen again.
