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The problem is that Windows isn't able to draw the text onto a 32-bit surface so I have to do the drawing of the alpha mask and the actual text separately. This will change all pixels to the destination color and the text will look blurry. I'll have to see if it's possible to disable the cleartype in Rainlendar.
