I am trying to convert an old skin that I was using to the new format and I am having a couple of problems. The skin is horizontal with the first letter of the day name over the date. In the new format I can only get the day name to show as Sun, Mon, Tue etc. I just want S, M, T. I am also having trouble getting the day name to start correctly...the first of the month always seems to default to the day name I specify in the options as the first day of the week (in my case Sunday). I hope this makes sense. Any help would be appreciated.

One other question...what are the commands to use for a button to toggle the todo list and the event list from the calendar? In the .ini it was "RainlendarToggleEventList" etc.
