I'm not sure wether this has been suggested but...

Make it possible to have the maximum height of the To do and Event windows to constant (no resize regardless of To do/Event amount)

And/Or

Make the To do and Event windows go downwards instead of upwards.

In other words, have the To do and Event windows glued to the calender !

It is for me anoying that the calender moves upwards on the desktop, I allways keep it at the lower right part of the screen, but depending on the amount of To do's and/or Events, the calender moves opwards or even out of the screen.

Does the log show any errors related to the sidebar? It also could be that the window is outside the screen for some reason (although Rainlendar should prevent this from happening).

Yes, I can set up a wiki if there is interest for it. It might be a better place to write e.g. the skinning docs as the current help system is somewhat limited.

You can add new events also by double clicking the day on the calendar (this is mentioned in the manual :-).

Allready done that, but that only forces a maximum height, not a constant height.

Although this is not what I'm actually looking for.

What I'm looking for is an option to tell the event and/or to do windows to grow upwards instead of downwards, so that the calender stays in it's original position.

You can also use the Sidebar window from Shadow4 which has the calendar, the event list and the todo list all in the same window.

The siderbar is cool, but I prefer to have the calendar at the bottom of the screen not the top !
