## Rainlendar 2.4 build 70

Linux TAR (32-bit): Rainlendar-2.4.b70-i386.tar.bz2

Linux DEB (32-bit): rainlendar2-pro\_2.4.b70-1\_i386.deb

Mac OS X (Intel): Rainlendar-2.4.b70.dmg

This is beta version! It has not been tested.

- o Defining a folder for Outlook calendar's settings caused the Options dialog to hang. Fixed.
  - o Https support was broken in Linux builds. Fixed.
  - o Added the tray icon to the menu bar on Mac.
  - o Added "Show dock icon" setting to the advanced options on Mac.
  - o Traytip is not shown at all anymore if the "Show today's events on startup" is set to "No".
  - o Added new option to "Combine icons in the calendar" to show only one icon per day.
  - o Alarm gets hidden automatically if the event's calendar is disabled.
  - o Categories with &-char are displayed correctly in the selection list.
  - o Added "abbreviate" for the month element in the xml format skins.
  - o It's now possible to define how many backup files are preserved from the advanced options. Set the value to 0 to disable the automatic backups.
  - o The license file can be installed from the context menu also (the item is only shown in unregistered Pro version).
  - o Column sizes were set incorrectly if the order was different than the default.

From what I read moving the icon cannot be done except by using some internal undocumented OS X functions which I'm not sure I want to do. I did take a look at the iCal support but it seems that at least it's own API doesn't provide the recurring events/tasks as a single item so it's not very usable (read-only support might be possible though). I'll have to check if there is some other way to get access to the event/task data.

Guess that there is something rather more important to fix:

When I startup this RL beta on Mac OS X 10.5 (Intel), on which I have some remote calendars, and their host is unavailable - then RL Pro will hang when I try to quit the program. I noticed this in some earlier versions already.

In this beta now, most of my RL GUI disappears when I try to quit, but the menu bar icon remains (inresponsively).

Dunno what response or event RL waits for. I try to force quit the app, but it is not listed in the stack of running software any more.

nihilist, The problem with the 64-bit builds is that I don't have enough room for the 64-bit OS on my hard disk so making them requires extra work. The first 64-bit build was b66 so if that doesn't work then you need to wait for until I have time to create a new build.

ifoow, I noticed also the problem with the tray icon. I'll fix that. Is the offline file created at all? It should be in `~/.rainlendar2/backups/` (the file name has text "Offline").

observer, does the menu bar icon remain only when you have network calendars which cannot be accessed or also if you disable all your calendars? At the moment Rainlendar waits forever for the network threads to quit before it exists so if one of them is stuck the process won't die (the network connection should timeout at some point though which would free the thread). I can check if it's possible to kill the thread if it cannot be quit nicely.

I tested it right now and the "disable all calendars" has shown no effect on the behaviour for me.

Rainlendar GUI -> right click in "events" heading -> "calendars" -> "disable all calendars"

All shared calendars disappeared when I had loaded them from server correctly before.  
Result: Quit process without any errors.

Same steps when remote calendars were offline.  
Result: Quit process erratic as described in my previous post.
