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This could just be me but the latest release is causing me some problems.

Changing month is sluggish: I can change the month once quickly but there will then be a delay before I can change it again. I've also noticed that changing month or using a tooltip causes other fonts to sort of shimmer or shake. Tooltips are also slow to appear and disappear especially when moving from one tooltip to another. Refreshing the calendar is also slow and creates shimmering of fonts.

Not all my fonts shimmer but some i've noticed so far include ones on the taskbar and itunes. I'm pretty sure its a cleartype issue (I have cleartype enabled).

EDIT: I just noticed that I can't change the month/bring up a tooltip until the shimmering has stopped. It looks like the fonts are changing between cleartype on/off which is causing the effect. Its happening to text in my web browser too.

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I'm having issues with 2.0.1 also. After the initial install, it p[umped CPU usage to 100% and never loaded the calendar on the desktop.

Killed and restarted and got a dialog saying it could use my settings so I had to reset everything. It started fine then, but I had lost all my calendars.

So I went in and tried to readd my calendar files (I have 10 calendar files for my differing item categories, all in iCal format), and the second I closed the options box, CPU usage jumped back up to 100% and calendars on the desktop are gone again.

As it is, 2.0.1 is unusable for me as I cannot use multiple iCal files with it as I could with the previous version. So I am going to have to try to go back to the previous version and rebuild all my settings.

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I had the same problem with the CPU usage in the build27 and this latest 2.0.1 release. With my particular configuration I have the default.ics file in a non-default directory. You may want to check out my comments in the BETA forum. When the problem came back with the 2.0.1 release I had to fall back to the working build26 and export my events...then remove build26 and install the 2.0.1 release and import the files back. Everything seems to be working OK now.
